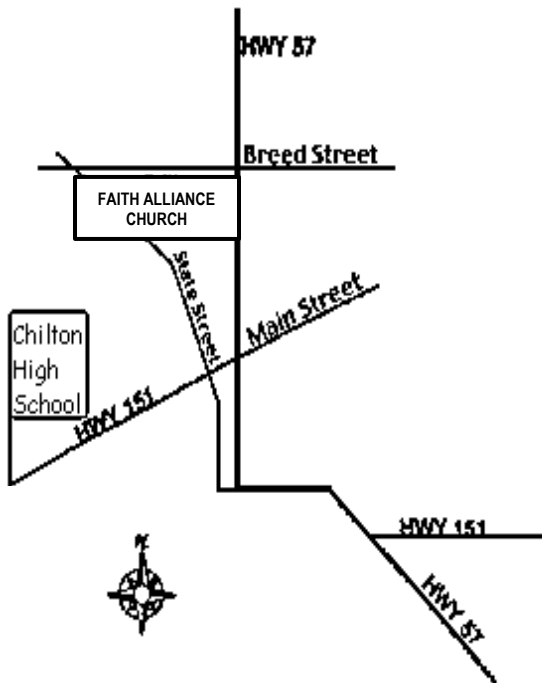


## DIRECTIONS TO FAITH ALLIANCE CHURCH

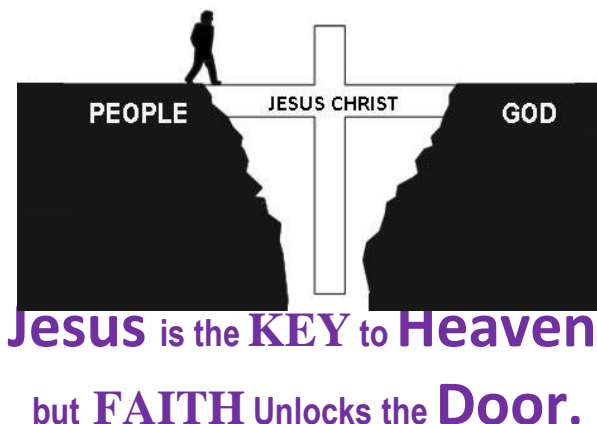
